Otherwise her work is considered satisfactory. Would it not be possible to have an English speaking teacher to take charge of the classes ? I am recommending that the second hand school desks purchased by the school to the amount of \$42.00 be made good by the Department. It is mentioned that you are ill provided with fire protection and I would like to know in detail what are your resources in this line, so that it may be determined what you should be provided with. 
